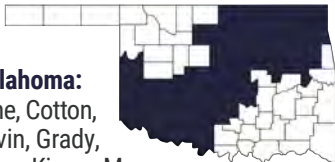
WHO WE ARE

Supportive Services for Veteran Families (SSVF) is a rapid rehousing program of the Community Service Council funded by a U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs grant. Using the Housing First model, we provide temporary intervention and short-term assistance to low-income veteran families who are homeless or facing eviction across 42 counties in Oklahoma.

WHO WE SERVE

Veterans in these 42 counties in Oklahoma:

Beckham, Caddo, Cherokee, Comanche, Cotton, Craig, Creek, Delaware, Garfield, Garvin, Grady, Greer, Harmon, Jackson, Jefferson, Kay, Kiowa, Mayes, McClain, Muskogee, Noble, Nowata, Okmulgee, Osage, Ottawa, Pawnee, Payne, Roger Mills, Rogers, Stephens, Tillman, Tulsa, Wagoner, Washington, and Washita, Oklahoma, Canadian, Cleveland, Lincoln, Logan, Pottawatomie and Seminole.



ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- ★ Veterans who served in the active military *and* any discharge other than dishonorable
- ★ Household income is below 50% of the area median income
- ★ Veteran is homeless or imminently facing eviction within 21 days



Additional screening may be required.
