ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The Staff Sergeant Parker Gordon Fox Suicide Prevention Grant Program enables VA to provide resources toward community-based suicide prevention efforts to meet the needs of veterans and their families through outreach, suicide prevention services, and connection to VA and community resources.

Services

- » Case management services
 - » Peer support services
 - » VA benefits assistance
- » Baseline mental health screening for risk
 - » Education on suicide risk and prevention to families
 - » Provision of clinical services for emergency treatment
- » Assistance obtaining/coordinating other benefits provided
 - » Assistance with emergent needs with issues that may contribute to the risk of suicide including social isolation, loneliness, and transition challenges.



Eagle Ops Rally Points

"Eagle Ops Rally Points" are predetermined locations where veterans gather and regroup during transition from service. They serve as meeting places for veterans to re-establish communication, build relationships and camaraderie, and ensure the safety and effectiveness of their transition through resource connection. These rally points directly combat isolation and loneliness associated with veteran suicide.



BE PART OF THE SOLUTION

Veterans connected to the VA saves lives by statistically reducing the rate of suicide by 60%.
